

This guide details the full process to virtual instrument authorization.

It consists in 2 major steps:

1. **Register your synthesizer** on your Arturia account
2. **Download a license** on your eLicenser dongle (being virtual or hardware)

⚠ The screenshots displayed hereunder have been taken on a specific platform, which could differ from yours. That should not confuse you, as only some minor graphical or language details may vary with your platform; the same process applies on all platforms!

1 Registration

Log into your Arturia account; if none, just create one:

www.arturia.com/login

Then go to the "My Registered Products" section:



Click the "Add" button, and fill the fields with the help of your registration card:

If everything went correctly, you should now be displayed a confirmation message:

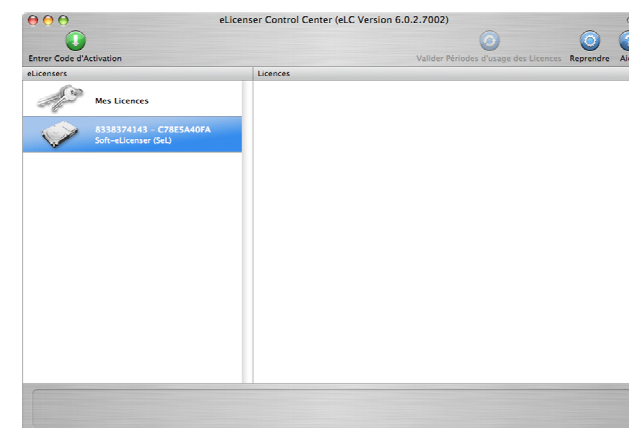
Copy this activation code to the clipboard; you will need it right now for step #2: **Authorization**.

Windows: [Ctrl]+C
Mac OS X: [Command]+C

2 Authorization

When installing your virtual instrument, a third-party application has been installed: the **eLicenser Control Center**, or "eLC".

Depending on your OS, just launch it from the *Start>Programs>eLicenser* (Windows) or *Finder>Applications* (Mac OS X) menu entries.



Once launched, **click on the "Enter Activation Code" green button**, this will prompt you to a window where you can paste your activation code.



How to paste?

Windows: [Ctrl]+V
Mac OS X: [Command]+V

Check the license matches your synthesizer, if so click on "Continue".

You are now prompted to **select the destination dongle**, being virtual or hardware.



Soft-eLicenser virtual dongle (default)

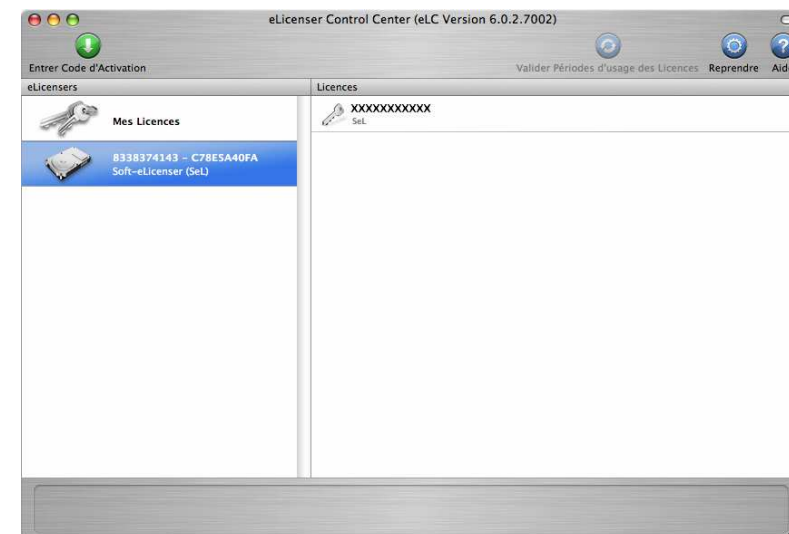


USB-eLicenser hardware dongle (optional)

Once done, the license will **start being downloaded**; a confirmation window will warn you about the process completion.

You should now **see your license stored** on the selected dongle.

You are now ready to launch your virtual instrument in standalone mode to check that everything runs just fine!
